



HIT OR MISS LOTTERY GAME CONDITIONS

These Game Conditions apply, until amended or revised, to the HIT OR MISS lottery game.

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 HIT OR MISS is governed by the Rules Respecting Lottery Games of the Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation (the "Corporation") which are available upon request and which include limitations of liability.
- 1.2 Words used in the HIT OR MISS Game Conditions which are used in the Rules Respecting Lottery Games shall have the same meaning as those used in the Rules Respecting Lottery Games.

2.0 Game Participation

- 2.1 A player may play only one selection per ticket. For each selection, the player shall select 12 numbers from the set of 24 consecutive numbers from 1 to 24.
- 2.2 Each HIT OR MISS selection shall cost \$2.00.
- 2.2 Quick Pick, Advance Play and Repurchase Play are also available.
- 2.3 A player must pay the retailer for his/her ticket, and the retailer must receive such payment, prior to the retailer delivering the ticket to the player.

3.0 The Draw

- 3.1 Draws are conducted at 5:00 minute intervals (approximately) according to the following schedule. All draw times are in Eastern Time.

- 3.2 Each draw, the Corporation shall draw, by electronic means, at random and without repetition, twelve (12) numbers ("winning number") from the set of 24 consecutive numbers from 1 to 24.
- 3.3 Each draw is assigned a unique draw number. Ticket(s) are eligible only for the draw(s) indicated on the ticket.
- 3.4 The player's ticket is entered into the next available draw(s) at the time of purchase.

4.0 Prize Structure

With respect to any draw, where the selection matches the mechanic noted below, each selection may win only one prize (i.e., the prize with the larger dollar amount), and the one prize is determined based on all (and not less than all) of the winning numbers matched by that selection. For clarity, the prize with the largest dollar amount is \$250,000, while the prize deemed to be the prize with the smallest dollar amount is a Free Play. The prizes are:

*For specific promotional draws, the Corporation may announce and make available a Prize above \$250,000.

- (a) A Free Play prize shall consist of one (1) twelve-number Quick Pick selection for the HIT OR MISS lottery game, for the upcoming draw after the Free Play prize redemption.

- (b) The Corporation limits the total amount payable per draw for the aggregate of the “Match 12 of 12” and “Match 0 of 12” top prize categories to \$1,500,000. Should the aggregate of these two prize categories for any given draw result in the liability limit being exceeded, the prizes of the categories are determined in proportion to the amount that would, except for this provision, and otherwise have been available to be won on the winning selections of these categories. In no event shall a “Match 12 of 12” or “Match 0 of 12” prize winner be paid less than five hundred and one dollars (\$501.00).
- (c) In making the calculations required by this section, the Corporation shall express the quotient resulting from such division in dollars and cents with the number of cents being rounded to the nearest ten cents or multiple thereof. Where the number of cents is less than five, the number shall be rounded down and where the number of cents is five or more, the number shall be rounded up.

5.0 Refunds

- 5.1 For tickets with one or more draw where no draw on the ticket has closed, a player may obtain a refund if all Refunds criteria set out in paragraph 2.2(a) of the Rules Respecting Lottery Games are met. For clarity, the refund must be sought and completed prior to the close of play for the first draw associated with the ticket.
- 5.2 For tickets with more than one draw where at least one draw has closed, a player may obtain a refund for any remaining draws on his/her HIT OR MISS lottery ticket. The player will receive a reissued ticket for the closed draws on his/her original ticket and a refund for the remaining draws if: (i) all applicable Refund criteria set out in paragraph 2.2(a) of the Rules Respecting Lottery Games are met; and (ii) the refund has been sought and obtained within 30 minutes after the close of the first draw on the ticket on the same day of purchase. For clarity, no refund will be provided for any draws that have closed by the time that the retailer has, in the Corporation’s sole discretion, completed the refund request.

6.0 Miscellaneous

- 6.1 The Corporation may amend these Game Conditions at any time and in any manner.
- 6.2 The headings in these Game Conditions are for convenience of reference only and do not affect the interpretation of these Game Conditions.
- 6.3 Unless otherwise specified by the Corporation, these Game Conditions are confirmed to be effective and supersede previous Game Conditions for the HIT OR MISS lottery game as of January 9, 2018.
